We were happy again to host a pick-up stop for the WION Food Drive. They collected over 8,000 pounds in donations during the three-day event. The ICHS also participated in the M-1 Credit Union's Non-Profit event in downtown Ionia.

The sales of DVD copies of the historic Ionia films have been outstanding, with orders for more coming in continually. David McCord assures everyone that more copies are in production now, just awaiting the DVD cases to put them in. Christmas gift orders will be filled on time! In addition, sales of the Bertha Brock History booklet have been brisk.

There are fewer trees on the Blanchard grounds now. Several diseased trees have been felled and the clean-up of brush and branches is underway. Through some bargaining, this process will not cost the Historical Society.

Treasurer Hank Knoop reported that expenses outpaced income over the past two months, but this was mostly due to the payment for the roof work that we had done. He expressed thanks to Larry Tiejema,

our accountant, for his generous discounts for preparing the year-end reports for 2011. Dues and donations have been very generous of late, and we realized nearly \$500 from the Cemetery Tour in October, and over \$600 at the Mrs. Claus Bazaar. Thanks again to the volunteers that made all this happen (and of course the spenders!)

The Quilt Raffle is in full swing, and tickets are available from any Board Member or at the House where the quilt is on display.

There was some talk of further promotions and plans for next year as the members finished their desserts. Several participants in the Cemetery Tour presented their characterizations for the entertainment of the guests, followed by "Season's Greetings" all around as the folks departed for the last meeting of the year.
